Reference	Measures In Place To Reduce The Risk				
1	➤ One way system in place for accessing the velodrome from the car park and then via the back straight of the velodrome (see diagram below).				
2	➤ Exit from the velodrome will be via the main centre forecourt leading to the car park (see diagram below).				
3	➤ Cyclists must dismount from their bikes and practice social distancing (as per Welsh government guidance) around the one way system.				
4	➤ Spectators and club coaches must adhere to the one way system and practice social distancing (as per Welsh government guidance) at all times				
5	➤ Social distancing boxes will be provided for spectators to occupy around the perimeter of the velodrome.				
6	➤ Signage in place to direct velodrome users around one way system and inform of social distancing practices (as per Welsh government guidance).				
7	➤ Centre web site updated with the latest arrangements for velodrome access and use.				
8	➤ Cycling clubs using the velodrome must provide a bespoke Covid risk assessment to the centre GM which is then approved for implementation by PM.				

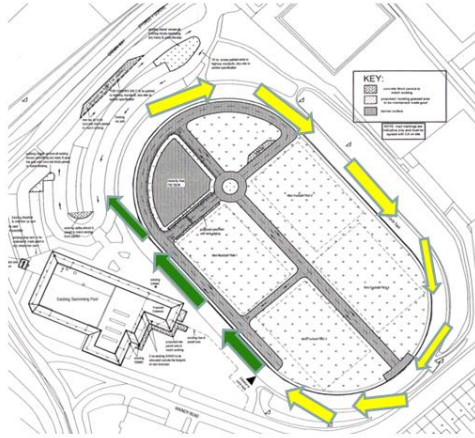

Ref	<u>Measures In Place To Reduce The Risk</u>
9	➤ Cycling activity covid risk assessments must adhere to the latest governing body guidance.
10	➤ All club hire is booked by email via the GM and paid electronically by invoicing.
11	➤ Clubs must factor in an appropriate gap between booking sessions to manage social distancing.
12	➤ Club activity must be self reliant for first aid provision for all their session types.
13	➤ No access to the centre for changing and shower facilities will be permitted
14	➤ Access to ground floor toilet facilities will be a one in one out system controlled by the centre queue marshall. Exit of the building will be via the gym user group.
15	➤ Velodrome gates are sanitised by a member of Maindy staff after each session.
16	➤ Maindy Centre staff will provide First Aid provision for casual use of the velodrome.
17	➤ The cycle store will not be accessible until further notice.
18	➤ Junior coaching activities by Maindy Centre staff will not be permitted until further notice.
